Yes, what a day it was, the Jaguar's gleaming in the Sun light, surrounded by shaded Trees, with beautiful Yacht's in the background. Nice end to a great day.

In an effort to simplify the collection and tracking of dues renewals our 2nd Vice President John Welch unveiled the following payment plan at our last breakfast meeting:


Members who joined or renewed in Q4 2016, would become due on January 1st, 2018 (\$65 for a full year)

Everyone would then become due on January 1st, 2018.


New memberships will be available at \$65 for January - June 2017 / \$45 for July - December 2017.






